

Discussion on Occupational Health and Safety in Montenegro for the Morning Program on RTCG

September 27, 2022.

Đina Janković, project coordinator of the Safety at Work Association of Montenegro, spoke on the Morning Program of RTCG on September 27, 2022, about the safety of construction sites in Montenegro, the extent to which the regulations defined by the Law on Occupational Health and Safety are respected, and whether employers are allowed to tolerate shortcomings such as inadequately prepared work sites and lack of protective equipment. She also highlighted the recent incident that occurred on September 23 at a construction site on Tuški put, where three workers were injured.



She pointed out the significant problem of a lack of records of injuries and occupational diseases. The focus of the conversation was on the conclusions of the meeting with the Ministry of Education regarding possible collaboration and the introduction of occupational health and safety subjects into the educational system of Montenegro. She urged young people to access the handbook "What Young People Need to Know About Occupational Health and Safety," developed by the Safety at Work Association of Montenegro, with the aim of informing young people about their basic rights, obligations, and responsibilities in the workplace, as well as those related to occupational health and safety.
