

Izvještaj o medijskoj zastupljenosti i gostovanjima

Gostovanje povodom obilježavanja Svjetskog dana zaštite i zdravlja na radu, 28. april 2020.

28. aprila 2020, Đina Janković je ispred Udruženja zaštite i zdravlja na radu imala priliku da gostuje na nacionalnom javnom servisu, s ciljem obilježavanja značaja ovog datuma, koji je Međunarodna organizacija rada (ILO) proglasila za Svjetski dan zaštite i zdravlja na radu. Od 1996. godine ovaj dan u 120 zemalja svijeta obilježava se kao međunarodni dan sjećanja na poginule radnike pod motom „Sjetimo se mrtvih, borimo se za žive“, s posebnim akcentom na prevenciju povreda na radu i profesionalnih oboljenja. Uprkos situaciji uzrokovanoj pandemijom COVID-19, kako bi se obilježio ovaj dan i odala počast i priznanje svim ljekarima i ostalim medicinskim radnicima koji su posljednjih mjeseci izgubili živote na svojim radnim mjestima širom svijeta, Đina Janković je najavila održavanje online konferencije tog dana preko Zoom aplikacije, čiji je cilj podjela iskustava učesnika o aktuelnoj situaciji iz njihovog ugla, odnosno o stanju zaštite i zdravlja na radu u vrijeme korone.



Gostovanje na nacionalnom javnom servisu, 27. jul 2020.

Udruženje zaštite na radu Crne Gore je, zajedno s kolegama iz regiona, kreiralo smjernice za sprječavanje širenja COVID-19 na radnim mjestima. Ovom prilikom, Đina Janković je svojim gostovanjem na nacionalnom javnom servisu, predstavila ove smjernice. Smjernice su urađene u vidu zanimljivog animiranog videa, koji na slikovit način prikazuje postupke i mjere kojih zaposleni i poslodavci treba da se pridržavaju, kako bi se spriječilo, odnosno na najmanju moguću mjeru dovelo širenje virusa COVID-19. Zaposleni i poslodavci su se na zanimljiv i slikovit način upoznali sa potrebnim mjerama sprečavanja virusa COVID-19 na svojim radnim mjestima. Primjenjujući smjernice koje je Udruženje zaštite na radu izradilo, zaposleni i poslodavci omogućili su sebi siguran i zdrav rad u svom radnom okruženju.

Tom prilikom Đina Janković je govorila i o vjornim izazovima u oblasti ZZNR – problemima implemencije Zakona o ZZNR na terenu, nedovoljnoj zastupljenosti zaštite i zdravlja na radu obrazovnom sistemu u CG, kao i nedostatku Nacionalnog savjeta za ZZNR u Crnoj Gori.

Report on media representation and guest appearances

Guest appearance on the World Day for Safety and Health at Work, April 28th 2020.

On April 28th 2020, Djina Jankovic had the opportunity to represent the Safety at Work Association of Montenegro, as a guest on the national public service, with the aim of marking the significance of this date, which The International Labor Organization (ILO) has declared World Day for Safety and Health at Work. From 1996, this day has been marked an international day in 120 countries around the world, in memory of those who died in their workplaces, under the motto "Remember the dead, fight for the living", with a special focus on the prevention on injuries at work and occupational diseases. Despite the situation caused by the pandemic COVID-19, in order to mark this day and pay tribute and recognition to all the doctors and other medical workers who have lost their lives in their jobs in the recent months around the world, Djina Jankovic used the opportunity to announce an online Zoom conference that day, whose goal is to share the experiences of participants about the current situation from their point of view, on the state of safety and health at work in the times of the corona.



Guest appearance on the national public service, July 27th 2020.

The Safety at Work Association of Montenegro has, together with colleagues from the region, created guidelines for preventing the spread of COVID-19 in the workplace. On this occasion, Djina Jankovic had the opportunity to present these guidelines, by guest appearing on the national public service. The guidelines are created in the form of an interesting animated video, which, in a vivid, way shows the procedures and measures of which employees and employers should adhere, in order to prevent, or to minimize the spread of the COVID-19 virus. This way, employees and employers have been acquainted with the necessary measures to prevent the COVID-19 virus in their workplaces in an interesting and picturesque way. By applying the guidelines developed by the Safety at Work Association of Montenegro, employees and employers have enabled themselves to work in a safe and healthy manner in their work environment.

On that occasion, Djina Jankovic spoke about the many challenges in the field of OSH - problems in the implementation of the Law on OSH in the field, insufficient representation of safety and health at work in the educational system in Montenegro, as well as the lack of a National OSH Council in Montenegro.
