

Appearance on the "Mreža" show on RTCG 1

As a guest on the "Mreža" show on the Public Broadcaster, project coordinator Đina Janković provided an introduction to occupational health and safety, especially for younger viewers.

She also discussed the following topics:

- The legal framework regarding occupational health and safety and the level of compliance with the law;
- The level of awareness among young people about occupational health and safety;
- The availability of data on workplace injuries in our country and the existence of a register of injuries;
- The consequences of informal employment and the benefits of formal employment for young people;
- The workshops and lectures conducted in vocational high schools;
- The level of knowledge among high school students about this topic;
- Collaboration with the Ministry of Education and the consideration of introducing subjects related to occupational health and safety into the educational process.

She also announced the upcoming Regional Workshop on "Building the Capacity of Civil Society Organizations and Key Stakeholders for the Implementation and Monitoring of Existing Occupational Health and Safety Regulations and Working Conditions," organized by the Safety at Work Association of Montenegro (SWAM). The workshop will be attended by representatives from the Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare, Ministry of Education, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Health, Ministry of Ecology, Spatial Planning and Urbanism, Inspectorate Administration, Health Insurance Fund, and the Ombudsman for Human Rights and Freedoms. It will take place from October 26 to 28.
